

# The Showroom Floor Comparison Guide

Epoxy vs polished concrete for a commercial showroom, from Polished Floors

## Match the floor to the brand

### 1 Choose epoxy for colour and bold effect

Brand-matched colour, metallic, and flake finishes that polishing cannot reproduce.

### 2 Choose polished concrete for a minimal look

Natural, architectural, premium backdrop that lets product lead.

## Let the slab guide you

### 1 Sound, flat slab

A strong candidate for polishing, which exposes whatever is there.

### 2 Damaged or previously coated slab

Often better suited to a resurfacing epoxy system.

### 3 Always test for moisture

A damp slab can blister epoxy and affect how a polished floor seals.

## Plan around your schedule

### 1 Account for cure time with epoxy

Resin needs to cure before foot traffic and longer before rolling loads.

### 2 Account for grind time with polishing

Longer on site, but no cure window and no strong odour.

### 3 Get a reopening timeline in writing

Compare total cost including lost trading days, not just price per square foot.
